4. To contribute to the ongoing management and development of all programmes of study within the group including year tutorships and visiting sandwich placement students.
5. To undertake relevant subject development, research and other scholarly activity.
6. To work as an active member of and contribute to the development of the Designed Environment subject group.
7. To work in cooperation with the subject group's team of administrators.
8. To undertake other academic management duties appropriate to the post.
