<p><b>Job purpose:</b> To teach and research at undergraduate and postgraduate levels and to contribute scholarly activity and research, course management and development. The post holder will be expected to lead the development of a new MArch (Part 2), contribute to the other proposed postgraduate programmes in Urban Design, Sustainable Architecture and Interior Architecture.</p> <p>Applicants will be required to evidence experience and developed skills as well as a commitment to further develop their capabilities in either managerial, research and/or pedagogic related work.</p> <p><b>Principal duties and responsibilities:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. To teach and support project based learning on undergraduate and postgraduate programmes principally within architecture and design subjects and related programmes.</li> <li>2. Lead the development of a proposed MArch part 2 Architecture, and assist in the development of other postgraduate programmes in Urban Design, Sustainable Architecture and Interior Architecture.</li> <li>3. To contribute and where necessary lead the ongoing management and development of existing programmes of study</li> <li>4. To undertake subject and pedagogic development, research and other scholarly activity.</li> <li>5. To work as an active member of and contribute to the development of the Designed Environment subject group.</li> <li>6. To work in cooperation with the subject group's team of administrators.</li> <li>7. To undertake extensive personal research and in partnership with others in the subject group in pursuit of the School research strategy.</li> <li>8. Assist in providing course development and research and/or pedagogic leadership and guidance for academic colleagues across the subject group.</li> </ol>	

- 9. To manage the promotion of the research and consultancy based activities to external organisations including industry and the professions.
- 10. To undertake other academic management duties appropriate to the post.
- 11. To undertake extensive personal research and related activities in partnership with others in the subject group in pursuit of the School learning and teaching strategy.
